



BROKEN BRIDGE POETRY PRIZE

for independent secondary school students, grades 9 - 12

GUIDELINES:

1. At the time of submission, you must be enrolled in an independent secondary boarding or day school, grades 9 - 12. The contest director will check with schools on the enrollment status of all finalists.
2. **Winner receives** \$500 plus full scholarship to the Broken Bridge Summer Arts Workshop and publication in the *Broken Bridge Review*. **All finalists will appear** in *Broken Bridge Review*, and receive two contributor copies of the contest folio. *Broken Bridge Review* is a national literary journal for adult writers of poetry and fiction (brokenbridge.us).
3. All poems must be your own work and unpublished. "Anonymous" submissions will not be read.
4. **Contest deadline:** Submit **ONLY** between September 1 and November 15. Finalists are announced in February. The winner, in April.
5. One entry per participant. One entry equals:
 - a. one to three poems (typed); one poem per page. Your name must not appear anywhere on the poem(s); and
 - b. a separate page on which is typed (I.) your name, e-mail address, and home address; (II.) your school's name, address, and phone number; and (III.) the titles of your poem(s).
6. **IMPORTANT: Finalists will be announced by e-mail, so PLEASE include a reliable e-mail address in your original submission packet.** Submissions will not be returned. Do not submit electronically.
